

Safety instructions for the use of a hand-held tile cutter

1. Wear protective equipment:
Always wear appropriate personal protective equipment, including safety glasses, gloves and hearing protection, if necessary, to protect yourself from injury.
2. Prepare the work area:
Make sure the work area is clean and well lit. Remove any obstacles that could cause falls or accidents.
3. Check the appliance:
